Want Your Power Restored Quicker?

Have you changed your phone number? Cancelled your land line phone service? Changed cell phone service providers? If you answered “yes” to any of the questions above – here’s one more.

Have you updated your contact information with West Florida Electric? If not, this will cause an issue when you try to report a power outage at your home in the future.

During major power outages, WFEC implements the use of our automated outage reporting system, also known as PORCHE (Power Outage Response Call Handling Equipment). PORCHE has the ability to answer 12 telephone lines at the same time. This ability allows service center attendants to dispatch line crews to outage sites without having to stop and answer the phone numerous times. An entire room of live operators can’t handle the heavy volume of calls received by WFEC during widespread outages as efficiently as the PORCHE system can. 6833902

Updated & Accurate Customer Account Information is Required for Power Restoration Efforts

PORCHE prompts callers to enter a phone number, but if the number entered is not listed on an account, the automated system will not link to an account number or the location of the outage. In essence, the system cannot find your account number and will list the account number as unknown. However, if the number on an account

in the system is correct, then the account information and location are automatically pulled by the computer and displayed for service center personnel to use when dispatching line crews. This procedure not only enables WFEC to dispatch a crew to fix the problem, it also allows the



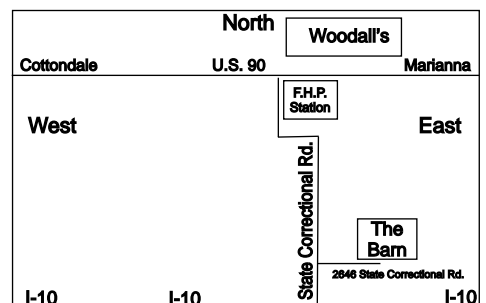

Calling All Birds

Categories of Calls for Turkey Hunting

When it comes to selecting turkey calls, my rule of thumb is no less than three totally different categories of calls. They can be a mixture of any three, but as a superstitious turkey hunter, I won't leave home without my personal favorites. Beyond superstition, there is some logic behind my motives. Turkeys are strange and finicky creatures and no one knows exactly why a particular call's pitch or tone triggers their interest.

dentures and those things just won't work for me. I made these different sized tube calls from both a small and a larger pill bottle. That gives me two different pitches. I also carry a slate and a box call. But, it's the tube calls that worked today because these birds have heard everything else."

That information has stuck with me ever since. The wise and seasoned hunter had three different categories of calls and checked them off much like a quarterback "checks off" at the



Well, over thirty-five years ago, as a high school kid, I remember seeing an elder hunter bring in a large gobbler from a state management area hunt. Having had no luck myself, I asked him which call had brought success. Around his neck, he displayed a lanyard that held two spray-painted Tylenol bottles. The tops had been carefully cut in half and were snapped tightly over a stretched membrane of latex rubber. 1920301

I guess he figured I was no threat to his hunting prowess, so he revealed the secret.

"I can't use those mouth yelpers you young guys use because I wear

line of scrimmage. When he found the one that worked, that's what he used.

Today, I don't carry a tube call simply because I never felt proficient with one. However, my three different categories of calls have varieties in each. When it comes to mouth yelpers, I've got a mixture of single reeds, split reeds, and double reeds. While each of these calls has a distinct sound, they are still classified in my first category of "mouth calls". They range from quiet and smooth, to loud and raspy.

In the slate category, I continue to carry two different styles of friction calls and three different strikers. This works to turn the two slates into an

unlimited range of friction produced calls. One of the calls is natural slate and produces very smooth and subtle clucks, purrs, and yelps. The other is composed of an all-weather composite material and is a bit brash in its volume and tone. Choosing to include a weather-resistant call in the slate line-up can be an important feature when the rain begins to fall. A little dampness shouldn't be the reason to take away an entire category of calls.

Last, but certainly not least, is the box call. Choosing a box call is sort of like trying on a sport coat. If it doesn't fit, there's no way to force it. Find one that fits your hands and is easy to hold and control. I went so far as to custom build my own from a combination of cedar, ash, and walnut woods. Most of the time involved hand tuning it to my personal style of calling. A good box call should make sounds that are discernable as actual calls rather than random squeaks and squawks.

These boxes range from the name brand retail shelf models, to highly collectible and custom signature designs. Simply buying an expensive

box call won't guarantee that it will be a suitable for hunting. In the end, it all comes down to finding out whether you can run a series of calls on it. A well tuned and properly handled box call can produce just about every sound in the turkey's dialogue. Clucks, purrs, yelps, cackles, and even a gobble can be produced with some practice. It is probably one of the most versatile of all the calls and the crisp sounds of a good box call will carry further than either the slate or a mouth yelper on those windy days. 7492101

Over the years, I've found that the selection of calls and the techniques used for our eastern turkeys is quite different from hunting the Rio Grand sub-species in Texas or the Osceola's of south Florida. However, all of these birds have one thing in common. There is at least one call in your arsenal to which they will respond and many others that will never turn their heads. Having at least three categories of calls at your disposal may work to increase the odds of bringing home a trophy bird. 🦃
