Considering solar energy for your home? Before you make that investment, it's important to know how solar energy will work for you. The energy experts at West Florida Electric Cooperative are here to help you with the process.

Many solar customers produce more power than they would typically use during the daylight hours; therefore, West Florida Electric Cooperative provides an outlet for them to export this excess power to the grid.



*When purchasing energy from West Florida Electric Cooperative (even if you own a solar energy system) you pay **12¢/kWh** for the first 1,000 kWh and 13¢ per kWh after that.

If you generate more energy than your home uses, you receive an energy credit of **5.2¢/kWh** for your net energy.



Before purchasing a solar array, contact us for assistance in calculating your potential savings. Solar contractors often use regional or national electric rates when calculating your potential savings, but our energy experts can provide you with information to help you make an informed decision.
