WFEC serves approximately 28,000 meters, providing dependable electricity & other services at competitive prices in Calhoun, Holmes, Jackson & Washington Counties in Northwest Florida.



We're powering savings by offering incentives to upgrade electric furnaces to high-efficiency heat pumps in new or existing manufactured homes. About <u>32%</u> of WFEC's members are manufactured homeowners. Here in Florida, more than 10 percent of homeowners buy manufactured homes. These residences serve a real need for affordable housing, but there is also a need for these homes to be more energy-efficient. Since they typically come with an electric furnace, we're launching a program to help manufactured home buyers, as well as existing owners, upgrade to a high-efficiency heat pump. This will lower electric use during cold months & save participants an average of \$550 per year on heating costs! For all of us who are already watching every penny, \$550 per year over many years really adds up.

# HOW IT WORKS:

## New Manufactured Home

- WFEC will pay the difference up to the limit
- A WFEC representative will do an inspection after the unit is installed at the home
- Rebates & dealer incentives should be received within 2 weeks of the inspection

### **New Manufactured Homes:**

• WFEC will pay the difference to the **manufactured home dealer** for an upgrade from an electric furnace to an air-source heat pump. The rebate will be paid directly to the manufactured home dealer on behalf of and for the benefit of the member.

#### We'll pay the difference not to exceed:

Up to \$400 for a 2 to 2.5 ton unit Up to \$600 for a 3 to 4 ton unit Up to \$700 for a 5 ton unit + \$100 Manufactured Home Dealer Incentive

### **Requirements:**

- Model & serial number of heat pump
- Mobile home data plate for HVAC sizing
- Cost difference between straight cool & heat pump clearly written on invoice
